



Dear Parents and Students:

DAVID LAWRENCE JR K8 CENTER IS A MANDATORY UNIFORM SCHOOL. A 10 day grace period is provided at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year for new or transferring students to obtain uniforms. ID's and uniforms are required - no exceptions.

UNIFORM POLICY LOWER ACADEMY

- Navy blue or khaki bottoms (dockers, cargo shorts, capris, skorts)
- Shorts and skorts must reach mid-thigh in length
- All shirts must be navy blue, light blue or white. Uniforms with the school crest or logo are available in the Dolphin Depot (school store) and PTSA profits benefit our students!
- Sweatshirts and jackets can be worn when the shirt underneath is a uniform shirt. Sweatshirts and jackets must be a solid white or navy blue in color. Writing, designs, slogans, or pictures of any kind are not permitted. **For safety reasons, wearing a hood while on campus is not permitted.**

UNIFORM POLICY UPPER ACADEMY

- **UNIFORM STYLE PANTS OR SHORTS ONLY** — The pants/shorts must be solid khaki or solid navy blue in color and appropriate in size. Pants must be belted at the waist. All shorts must reach fingertip in length (below mid-thigh).
- **UNIFORM STYLE POLO SHIRTS** — The shirts must be solid color white, light blue or navy blue. The polo shirt must have no more than three or four buttons and be long enough to be tucked in. The shirt must have a collar and sleeves. All undershirts must be solid white or navy blue. Uniforms with the school crest or logo are available in the Dolphin Depot (school store).
- **No jeggings, leggings, sweatpants, exercise pants/shorts, stretch pants/shorts, jeans (of any color or length), dresses or skirts.**
- **Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts** – Must be solid white or solid navy blue in color. Writing, designs, slogans, or pictures of any kind are not permitted. **For safety reasons, wearing hood while on campus is not permitted.**
- Shoes must be **CLOSED TOE/CLOSED HEEL ONLY** no sandals, slides or crocs.
- **BELTS** - Must be solid in color. No large buckles or metal studs are permitted.
- **Head gear** — Hats, skullcaps, scarves or bonnets are not worn while on campus. Headbands may be no wider than one inch in width.

Parents are called when the student is not properly dressed. Appropriate clothing needs to be brought to the office so the child may return to class. The uniform policy is implemented so we may readily identify our children for their safety and security.

School activities and event contracts require student compliance with the uniform policy.
