**Dear Parents and Students:** 

DAVID LAWRENCE JR K8 CENTER IS A MANDATORY UNIFORM SCHOOL. A 10-day grace period is provided at the beginning of the school year for new or transferring students to obtain uniforms.

## ID's and uniforms are required - NO EXCEPTIONS.

## <u>UNIFORM POLICY LOWER ACADEMY (Grades Prek-5)</u>

- Navy blue or khaki bottoms (dockers, cargo shorts, capris, skorts)
- Shorts and skorts must reach mid-thighs in length
- All shirts must be navy blue, light blue or white. Uniforms with the school logo may be purchased at Ibiley or Stitching Gone Wild.
- Sweatshirts and jackets can be worn; however, they must have the school logo or plain colored black or navy blue.



## NEW- UNIFORM POLICY UPPER ACADEMY (Grades 6-8)



- UNIFORM STYLE PANTS The pants must be solid khaki, black or navy blue. Pants must be belted at the waist.
- UNIFORM STYLE POLO SHIRTS NEW FOR 25-26 The shirts must be solid color grey or royal blue with the school logo. The polo shirt must have no more than three or four buttons and be long enough to be tucked in. The shirt must have a collar and sleeves.
- No jeggings, leggings, sweatpants, exercise pants/shorts, stretch pants/shorts, jeans (of any color or length), dresses or skirts.
- Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts Must be solid black or solid navy blue in color. Writing, designs, slogans, or pictures of any kind are **not permitted**. For safety reasons, wearing hood while on campus is not permitted.
- Shoes must be CLOSED TOE/CLOSED HEEL ONLY no sandals, slides or crocs.
- BELTS Must be solid in color. No large buckles or meal studs are permitted.
- Head gear Hats, skullcaps, scarves or bonnets are not worn while on campus. Headbands may be no wider than one inch in width.

Parents will be called when the student is not properly dressed. Appropriate clothing needs to be brought to the office so the child may return to class. The uniform policy is implemented so we may readily identify our children for their safety and security. School activities and event contracts require student compliance with the uniform policy.
